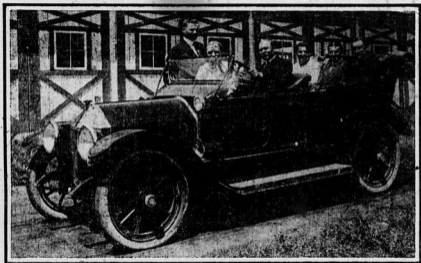


## FRENCH DRIVERS TRY OUT AMERICAN CAR.
