## CHEVOLAIR IN FINAL TEST

**New Motor Is Shipped to Chicago for Use in Airplane.**

The six-cylinder Chevovair motor, which has been made by the Chevovair Motors, Inc., to be used as the power plant of the Laird airplane to be driven in the Chicago air races August 23 to September 1, received its final tests this week and Tuesday was transported by truck to the plant of the Laird Company, Chicago. The testing was done at the Hoosier airport under supervision of Arthur Chevrolet, designer and builder of the motor and president of Chevovair Motors, Inc. A horse power of 217 was developed. Manny Laird, who will drive the Laird airplane with the Chevovair motor in the races, is a noted pilot and designer and manufacturer of airplanes.
