

Resta Is After the Big Coin

CHICAGO, Aug. 12.—Dario Resta the Italian demon, was picked as the winner of the Grand Prix auto race here today, but in the background loomed a dark horse in the person of Louis Chevrolet, whose Frontenac car may show unsuspected speed developments. He made 107.2 miles an hour in his qualifying rounds yesterday but Resta and his big Peugeot made the lap of the two mile track at the rate of 113.5 miles an hour.

Today's meeting is an innovation in auto racing. Five heats of 20 miles will be run. The winner of each heat qualifies for the 50-mile final. There is \$10,000 in prizes, split up as follows.

First, \$5,000; second, \$2,500; third, \$1,250; fourth, \$750; fifth, \$500.
