Louis Chevrolet of Indianapolis has completed the drawings for a new 4-in-line inverted air-cooled 80 horsepower motor for small airplanes. The same principles are to be used in a 110 horsepower six-cylinder motor and in a 140 horsepower eight-cylinder V-type.

Chevrolet also has in mind an improved radial type and a line of motors for the higher horsepower which the average sportsman flyer will probably demand five years from now.

Chevrolet is looking for a backer to build two motors of the 4-in-line 80 horsepower type, and put them thru the standard 50 hour test. This will require not less than \$25,000 nor more than \$50,000.
