CHEVROLET IN SMASH

Winner of 500-Mile Race and Five Others Escape Injury

Gaston Chevrolet, who won the 1920 Speedway race at Indianapolis, narrowly escaped serious injury in an automobile accident Sunday near Pymont, in Carroll county. Others in the car were Mrs. Gaston Chevrolet, Charles Chevrolet, Miss Margaret McConnell of New York; Jack Welsh, of Evansville, and Miss Ethel Atkinson, of Indianapolis. They were on the way from Indianapolis to Delphi to spend Sunday with Miss Margaret Atkinson, formerly Mrs. Charles Kirkpatrick.

As they crossed a bridge over Wildcat creek at Pymont the car struck a heavy truck and was thrown into a ditch and was badly damaged. All members of the party jumped from the automobile and escaped with a few cuts and bruises.
