Of course you realize that this would require a special pattern and casting, so for an experimental motor would it not be possible to bolt a larger flange on the existing flange. This would probably lengthen this part a trifle, but we wonder if it would be objectionable.

Of course on regular production for a substantial order we could furnish whatever flange you would require.
