
VIRGINIA FAIR SCHEDULES A BIG AUTOMOBILE RACE

Richmond, Va., Oct. 6.—Five thousand dollars and the world's championship is at stake, in the four-cornered match auto race, scheduled for next Saturday afternoon, October 12, the final day of the Virginia state fair. One thousand dollars has been posted by each of the four drivers, while the additional \$1,000 has been added by the Virginia State Fair association.

Arthur Chevrolet, the famous speedway star; Fred Horey, the dirt track champion; Leon Duray, another famous foreign pilot, and Jules Ellingboe, the Canadian champion, will battle it out on the Richmond course for the championship. The race will be run in three heats, of 10, 15 and 25 miles, and the winner will be decided upon by the point system. Horey will tool a record-holding Fiat; Chevrolet will drive a Case Special; Ellingboe has selected a Briscoe, and Duray will tool the Maxwell, that Eddie Rickenbacker handled, before he joined the colors. These four cars hold over 75 per cent. of the official world's records, so it is evident that these possess plenty of speed.
