

E. A. Hearne Wins Main Motor Race

TRENTON, N. J., Saturday.—With Eddie Hearne driving a Dusenbergs Special home in three races a crowd of 20,000 persons was thrilled to-day at the wind-up of the Trenton Fair. Ralph De Palma failed to show his usual speed in a Mercer and was forced twice to give way to Hearne. Ira Vail, in a Hudson super six, enthused the crowd by his skill and daring in the race in which he finished first.

Gaston Chevrolet was cheered when he continued in the last race after his Frontenac Special had caught fire twice. This event was on the programme for twenty-five miles, but the distance was reduced on account of darkness. Mr. Vail ran through the fence in the last race, but was uninjured. The summaries:—
