

G. Chevrolet Answers Ruth Law's Challenge

Noticing an article published in The Huntington Press, dated May 15, a challenge to Chevrolet, the world's greatest dirt track driver, I wish to state as a representative of Mr. Chevrolet that I accept her challenge on condition named in this article of agreement.

Chevrolet is now going to race at Sheephead Bay, where he will meet some of the best drivers in the world. If satisfactory arrangements can be made with Mr. Gordon who represents Ruth Law, during her exhibition flight at Huntington, Indiana, I will be pleased to meet her on May 28.

He must have his own choice of selecting any car he wishes to drive. She must state the distance she will fly when she makes the contest. We will also wager \$1,000 that Chevrolet can beat Ruth Law with his car. She must also name the distance of the race.

Chevrolet raced Ruth Law at Detroit last year, on August 31, and beat her by 300 feet, as the race was a close finish. He also raced her on Sunday, September 2, at Detroit and it was called no contest on account of being evenly matched on that date.



As we note you are very much interested in this match and would like to see it take place on Tuesday, May 28, will say that if things are arranged and suitable to all whom it concerns and agreements are satisfactory, we will make arrangements with Chevrolet to be there on that date and would ask you kindly to get in touch with Mr. John B.
