

2 AUTOS COLLIDE

LOUIS CHEVROLET'S MACHINE IN ACCIDENT.

Strikes Car Containing J. Dallas Dort and Another—Only Slight Damage Done.

Two model 10 Buick automobiles, one containing J. Dallas Dort and another man and the other containing Louis Chevrolet, the Buick racing driver, and his wife, collided at the corner of Saginaw and Kearsley streets at 8 o'clock last evening.

None of the occupants of either was hurt and but little damage was done to the machines. Mr. Dort had just driven off East Kearsley street to Saginaw street, and the Chevrolets were going north on the right-hand side of Saginaw street, Mrs. Chevrolet driving. Mr. Chevrolet grasped the steering wheel and attempted to turn his car so it would pass behind Mr. Dort's machine. It is said that Mr. Dort stopped his car when he saw the other coming. Not being able to turn out, the car containing Mr. and Mrs. Chevrolet swung around and hit the car driven by Mr. Dort broadside. The only damage to the cars was the jamming of the mud guards.
