GASTON CHEVROLET VICTOR OVER TOFT

Johnstown, Pa., Sept. 6.—Gaston Chevrolet, winner of the automobile classic race, Labor day at Uncintown speedway, this afternoon won the \$5,-000 match race from Omar Toft, the championship dirt track driver of the Pacific coast. The race of 26 miles held on the Luna race track, a half-mile oval, was run in five heats.

Chevrolet won the first heat of five miles in 6:121/2. The second and third heats of three and five miles were won by Toft in 3:36 and 5:39 respectively. Chevrolet easily won the remaining heats of three and 10 miles in 3:33 and 11:59 respectively.

Chevrolet broke the track record of 70 minutes to the mile held by Dresbrow, a French driver, by making a mile in 59 seconds. Dresbrow's record was made four years ago.
