

Rain Halts Trials.

Rain halted the trials forty-eight minutes before sundown and about nine cars still at the track will be given this forty-eight minutes starting at 6:30 o'clock this morning to nudge others out of the race.

The forty-second position in the present starting field* is held by Ralph Hepburn who qualified his Highway Parts Special at 106.760 miles an hour just as it started to rain. He finished his last lap at only a little better than ninety-eight miles an hour on the slippery track and this may cost him his place this morning. One of his laps was clocked at 110.220 miles an hour and he would have been safely in the field at better than one hundred and eight miles an hour had not rain interfered in his closing lap.
