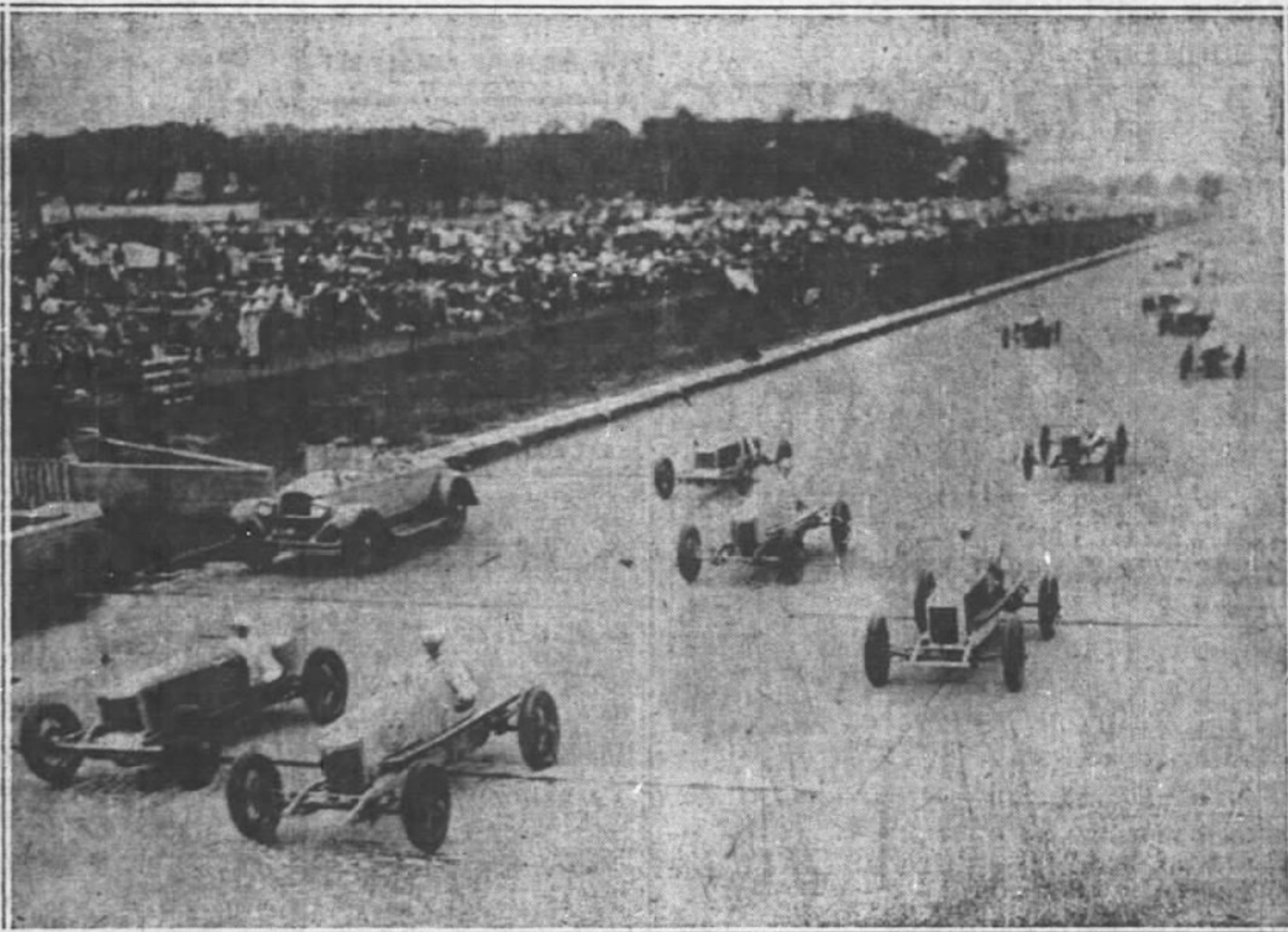


28 CARS LEAP IN PERFECT FLYING START
