

TIMERS, CHECKERS NAMED FOR PLANES

Other Arrangements Made for Ford Tour Reception Here Tomorrow.

Timers and checkers to serve upon the arrival and departure tomorrow morning of the seventeen planes participating in the reliability tour for commercial airplanes competing for the Ford trophy, were announced yesterday. The timers will assist Odis Porter, chief timer for the Indianapolis Motor Speedway, who will be chief timer for the planes.

The assistants will be Bert Coffin, football official and referee of Cornell university; Burt Westover, conference basket ball official; Thomas Murray, who has acted as timer for the national swimming meets held here, and Myron Tatlock, former coach at Shortridge high school. Fred Duesenberg will act as chief judge, with Arthur Chevrolet and G. A. Efroymsen as other members of the committee of judges.
