

## Mrs. Chevrolet Returns Home.

Mrs. Louis Chevrolet, formerly of Indianapolis, who has been visiting friends in Indianapolis three weeks, left Sunday in a Waco plane, equipped with a Chevrolet four-cylinder motor, made by the Chevrolet Aircraft Corporation of Baltimore, of which Louis Chevrolet is president.

The Chevrolet Aircraft Corporation is affiliated with the Glenn L. Martin Company.

The plane was piloted here by E. C. Burghduff, sales manager of the

Chevrolet Aircraft Corporation. They left for Cleveland, O., and expected to pick up Mr. Chevrolet and fly to Baltimore.

The new motor, which has been developed in the last three years by Mr. Chevrolet, recently was approved by the United States Department of Commerce, for use in commercial aircraft. It develops 120-horse power, weighs 260 pounds and is one of the most efficient engines tested at the bureau of standards in Washington.

Preparations are being made for large production of the motors.
