

AUTO CONTESTS FEATURE WAR CHEST CAMPAIGN

HUNTINGTON, Ind., May 28—More than 40,000 persons attended the War Chest program held at the Fair Grounds here this afternoon. It concluded a two days' program. Miss Ruth Law, aviatrix, featured the program with her exhibition flights and her race with Gaston Chevrolet, driving a Sunbeam. Miss Law beat Chevrolet a quarter of a mile in the two-mile race for a side bet of \$1,000. The gate receipts will go to the county War Chest. Miss Law's aero letter was auctioned off to Frank Book for \$10.

There were five events in the auto races. The two-mile race was won by D. E. Allen, driving a Buick, time, 2:50. The second event was a three-mile race, which was won by Wonderly in a Simplex, time, 4:00. The third event was the race between Chevrolet and Miss Law. The fourth was a half-mile race. The best time was made by Allen, driving a Buick, in thirty-eight seconds. The five-mile race was annulled because of rain. Prizes amounting to \$2,000 were awarded.
