YOUNGER CHEVROLET, AUTO ENGINEER, DIES

Arthur Chevrolet Jr., 23 years old, 3606 Haisam avenue, son of the president of Chevolair Motors, Inc., manufacturers of airplane motors, died yesterday in St. Vincent's hospital after an illness of several weeks.

Mr. Chevrolet was employed as a mechanical engineer by his father and worked on his father's racing cars. The elder Chevrolet is one of the designers of the Chevrolet motor, and Louis Chevrolet, an uncle of young Chevrolet, is a widely known race driver.

Arthur Chevrolet Jr. was born in New York, but spent most of his life in Indianapolis. He was a graduate of Cathedral high school and attended Purdue university three years. He was a member of Phi Gamma Delta Fraternity and Delta Sigma Nu, Indianapolis social fraternity.

Funeral Tomorrow.

Funeral services will be held at 8.20 o'clock tomorrow morning in the home of his parents, 1327 Central avenue, and at 9 o'clock in St. Joan of Arc Catholic Church. Burial will be in Holy Cross cemetery.

Mr. Chevrolet was a member of the St. Joan of Arc parish. Survivors are the widow, Mrs. Josephine Ball Chevrolet, to whom he was married about five months ago; the parents and a sister, Miss Anna Marie Chevrolet.
