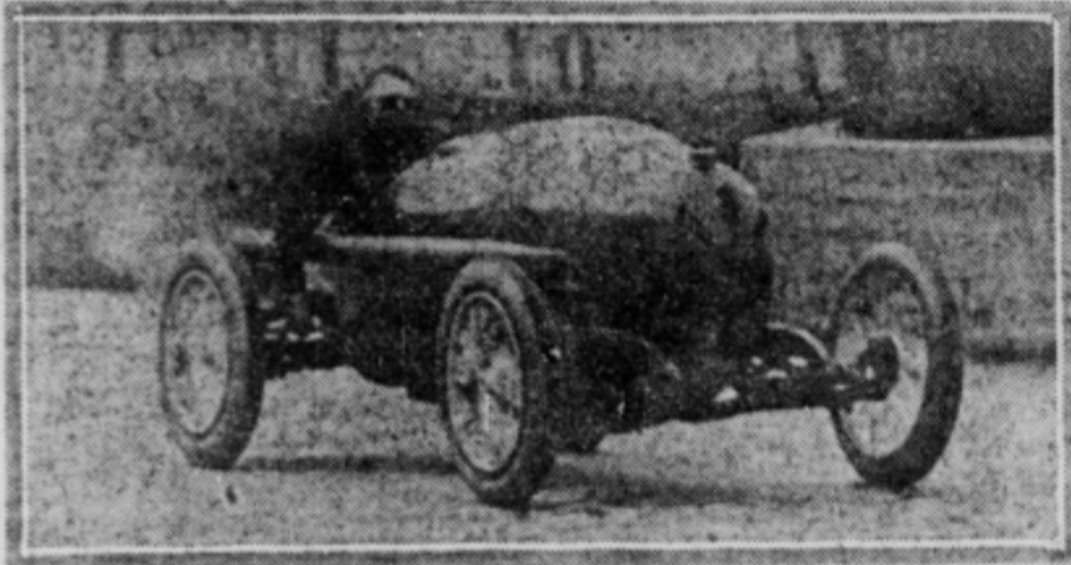


L. CHEVROLET IN MONROE
