When Bill Esterley, official starter, waved the black and white checkered flag at Gaston Chevrolet yesterday, he officially crowned the Indianapolis driver the 1929 king of the course and thus gave

to an Indianapolis-made automobile the honor of winning the big race.

Chevrolet's time for the 500 spin was 5 hours 38 minutes and 32 seconds, an average of 88.55 miles an hour.
