ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

2. The name/of this incorporation shall be:

CHEVROLET AIR CRAFT CORPORATION.

3. The business to be done by this corporation is:

To manufacture, buy, sell, lease, mortgage, export, and otherwise acquire, dispose of, and deal in aeroplane motors and aeroplanes, and vehicles of all kinds profelled by mechanical power, for use in air; to manufacture, buy, sell, and otherwise acquire, dispose of, and deal in any and all parts of such motors or aeroplanes, or both; and any and all kinds of engines and parts of engines, motors, devices and appliances, for the generation, manufacture, and use of steam, electricity, gas, compressed air, and other forms of power and power production, and all things incident to and used in connection therewith; to acquire land and buildings for the business described, and do all things a human being might do that are necessary, useful and proper to the conduct of the business.

5. The principal office or place of business of this corporation shall be located in Marion County, and the post office address shall be, Indianapolis, Indiana.

6. The business and property to be taken over by the corporation is as follows:
